2 bis Rue du Bon Pasteur (Centre d'Etudes Françaises)



2 bis Rue du Bon Pasteur, built in 1771 as a chapel known as "Chapelle de Penitent Bleus", now houses ACM-IAU's French Studies program. This building is a highly visible symbol of the Aixois roots of ACM-IAU, and has served as a rich backdrop for generations of American undergraduate students to learn the French language and cultural skills to open their eyes to the world.

Marchutz Campus

Named for the acclaimed painter and historian, Leo Marchutz, who taught at IAU from 1960-1973, the Marchutz School was created by a group of his followers. Following the death of Leo Marchutz, Amos Booth worked with the Board of Trustees to acquire his studio and workshop in 1984.

In 2022, ACM-IAU planted its very own vineyard on the Marchutz property, allowing the institution to offer a Wine Certificate Program, and a Global Wine Studies emphasis in the MBA program.

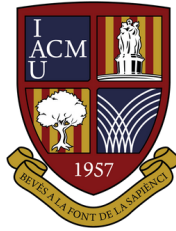
